Dr. Ryan Caesar is an entomologist with the University of Hawaii at Manoa's Department of Plant & Environmental Protection Sciences. He will share information about insect biology and native Hawaiian insect biodiversity and conservation. Dr. Ryan will also speak about the University of Hawaii's Insect Museum, which has the second largest collection of Hawaiian
